

# Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The Cochran County Commissioners Court conducted public hearings on August 14, 2008 and August 21, 2008 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the County of Cochran from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 17.25 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.5334 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$3,040,154.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.4934 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$3,564,031.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.4934 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$3,564,899.

The Commissioners Court is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 3, 2008 at the Cochran County Courthouse, 100 North Main, Morton, Texas 79346 at 9:30 a.m.
